- Recognize and respect the unique needs and limitations of Academy students.

- Listen to and affirm students while keeping strong professional boundaries.
- Engage with students so they feel valued and an integral part of the community.
- Communicate issues and concerns to Bucksbaum Academy staff via email, text, or phone call depending on situation.
- Collaborate with the other 8th floor RA, the Daum Residence Hall staff, and the Bucksbaum Academy staff on duties, responsibilities, and programming.
- 2-4 meetings per month with Bucksbaum Academy staff. These can be brief, casual meetings anytime during the regular work day.
- Attend move-in and Welcome Dinner in the fall.
- Attend approx. 5 hours of training before the beginning of the fall semester.
